You'll never believe this!! This is a TOTAL hoot! This came from my friend Shirley in Calgary:

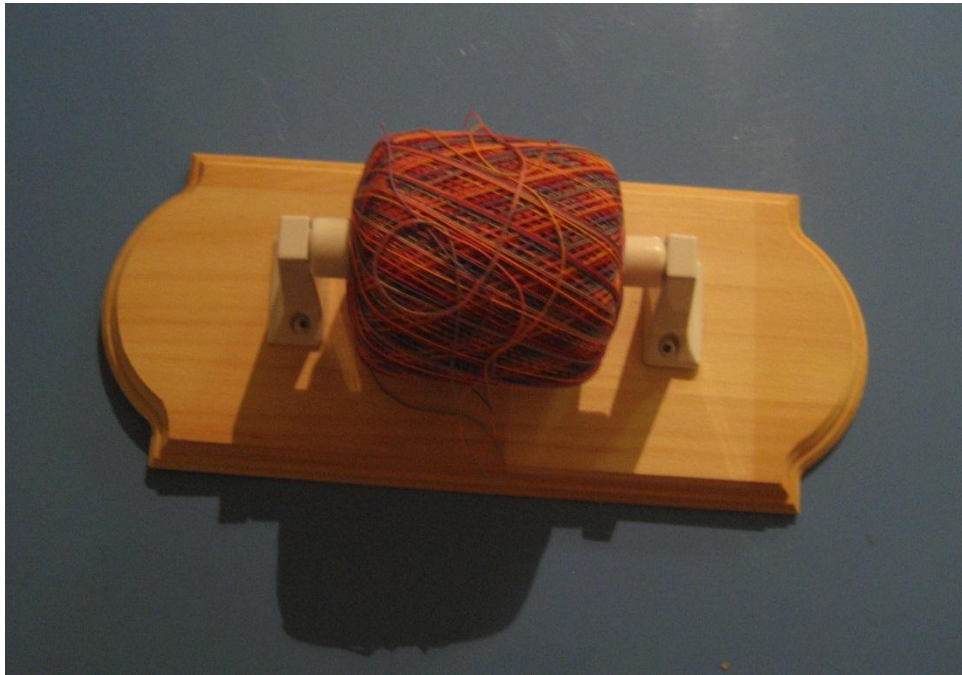

**OK – how about this:**

This easy-peasy craft project will sit on the floor or table and hold your ball or skein of yarn, allow it to unroll easily and keep it from rolling all over the place! AWESOME!!
